

Familiar seatbelt reminds patients to stay seated

Helps keep patients safely seated in wheelchairs. It sounds an alarm the moment a resident releases the familiar automobile-style buckle. Alarm sounds at one of two volume levels and flashes a red light, making it easy for staff to quickly locate patient at risk. With the optional Nurse Call Connector with Y-Adapter, alarm may be set to sound at the nurses' station without interfering with the patient's nurse call button.

The durable nylon web belt easily attaches to wheelchair's back uprights. Multiple mounting grommets ensure a correct fit.


